In March 2011, after days of heavy rainfall, floodwaters engulfed the remote Kimberley Aboriginal community of Warmun. Despite the efforts of Art Centre coordinator Maggie Fletcher & husband Gary to protect the Warmun Art Centre & its contents, a wall of water rushed through the building & smashed through the gallery. The Centre was devastated & piles of canvases washed into the creek. The support Warmun has received has been for temporary relief only, they have not received anything from insurance & there has been no financial assistance for rebuilding or refurbishment. Warmun Arts Centre is essential to this remote community - its art, central to the lives of the Gija people of Turkey Creek. On Sunday 13 November 2011, the ABF is holding an Art Auction of work by major artists from Warmun Art Centre (<http://www.warmunart.com/home.htm>) part of the sale proceeds will be provided to Warmun Art Centre for the restoration of the flood damaged building. **THROUGH THE GAP EDUCATION MENTORING:** Through the Gap Education Mentoring was granted funding by the ABF for its mentoring & personal development program offered to young indigenous members of the Glebe community & more specifically young members of the community involved in the Glebe PCYC. <http://www.pcy NSW.org/glebe>. **NAUIYU NAMBIYU INCORPORATED:** In 2010 a grant was awarded to Nauiyu Nambiyu Incorporated, Nauiyu Nambiyu (Daly River), Northern Territory, in support of its project to engage disadvantaged youth in activities designed to help prepare them for meaningful employment & to give them pride in their culture. The funds also assisted the organisation to establish a women's group & to arrange for minor renovations to a 'Men's Shed' used as a meeting place for men's business which allows elders to teach & mentor younger generations.
